- 9 And God said, "Let the waters under the heavens be gathered together into one place, and let the dry land appear." And it was so. And God saw that it was good. 13 And there was evening and there was morning, the third day.
- 14 And God said, "Let there be lights in the expanse of the heavens to separate the day from the night." 15 And God saw that it was good. 19 And there was evening and there was morning, the fourth day.
- 20 And God said, "Let the waters swarm with swarms of living creatures, and let birds fly above the earth across the expanse of the heavens." 23 And there was evening and there was morning, the fifth day.
- 24 And God said, "Let the earth bring forth living creatures according to their kinds—livestock and

creeping things and beasts of the earth according to their kinds."

27 So God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. 31 And God saw everything that He had made, and behold, it was very good. And there was evening and there was morning, the sixth day.
