Jesus is the Way

John 14:6, 18-19, 23-27

6 Jesus said: I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me." 18 "I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you. 19 Yet a little while and the world will see Me no more, but you will see Me. Because I live, you also will live.

23 If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word, and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him. 24 Whoever does not love Me does not keep My words. And the Word that you hear is not Mine but the Father's who sent Me. 25 These



things I have spoken to you while I am still with you. 26 But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you.

A Closer Look - The Law and the Gospel

- 1. What does it mean to be saved? (God makes His home with us. We are His children. He gives us peace. We will live with Him forever in heaven.)
- 2. How can we be saved? (If we believe that Jesus died for our sins and rose from the dead, we will be saved. This is the Gospel message.)
- 3. What does it mean that we are saved by Grace? (We cannot be good enough to be saved on our own. God saves us because of His great love for us.)
- 4. If we are saved by the Gospel, why would we want to keep God's Laws? (Because we are saved, we will want to obey God. We will want to do what pleases Him.)
- 5. What are the laws called that God gave to Moses? (*The Ten Commandments*) Name some of the Ten Commandments.
- 6. Why are the Ten Commandments important today? (Through these commandments, God teaches us how to live in harmony with God and with each other.)
- 7. No matter how hard we try, we can't keep the Ten Commandments. Who kept them perfectly for us? (Jesus kept them perfectly for us. Because of what He did for us, He is the Way to the Father.)
- 8. God said we should have not other gods before Him. What are some things that could take the place of God in our hearts? (Family, our home, friends, money, work.)
- 9. Life will not be easy because we are Christians. What comfort does Jesus give? (He told us not to be afraid. He promised His Spirit to keep us in the faith.)
