Yo soy el camino, la verdad y la vida;
nadie viene al Padre sino por Mí. Juan 14:6

Juan 14:6, 18-19, 23-27 - *Jesús, el Camino al Padre*

6 Jesús le dijo:--Yo soy el camino, la verdad y la vida; nadie viene al Padre sino por mí.

18 No os dejaré huérfanos; volveré a vosotros. 19 Todavía un poco, y el mundo no me verá más, pero vosotros me veréis; porque yo vivo, vosotros también viviréis.

23 Respondió Jesús y le dijo:--El que me ama, mi palabra guardará; y mi Padre lo amará, y vendremos a él y haremos morada con él. 24 El que no me ama no guarda mis palabras; y la palabra que habéis oído no es mía, sino del Padre que me envió.

25 Os he dicho estas cosas estando con vosotros. 26 Pero el Consolador, el Espíritu Santo, a quien el Padre enviará en mi nombre, él os enseñará todas las cosas y os recordará todo lo que yo os he dicho.

27 La paz os dejo, mi paz os doy; yo no os la doy como el mundo la da. No se turbe vuestro corazón ni tenga miedo.

John 14:6, 18-19, 23-27 - *Jesus is the Way*

6 Jesus said: I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

18 I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you. 19 Yet a little while and the world will see Me no more, but you will see Me. Because I live, you also will live.

23 If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word, and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him. 24 Whoever does not love Me does not keep My words. And the Word that you hear is not Mine but the Father's who sent Me.

25 These things I have spoken to you while I am still with you. 26 But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you.

27 Peace I leave with you; My peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid.

A Closer Look: The Law and the Gospel

1. What does it mean that Jesus is the only way to the Father? (*Our only hope for a close relationship with God is to believe in Jesus.*)
2. What does it mean that we are saved by Grace? (*We cannot be good enough to be saved on our own. God saves us because of His love for us.*)
3. How can we be saved? (*If we believe that Jesus died for our sins and rose from the dead, we will be saved.*)
4. If we are saved by the Gospel, why would we want to keep God's Laws? (*Because we are saved, we will want to obey God. We will want to do what pleases Him.*)
5. What are the laws called that God gave to Moses? (*The Ten Commandments*)
6. Name some of the Ten Commandments.
7. Why are the Ten Commandments important today? (*Through these commandments, God teaches us how to live in harmony with each other.*)
8. No matter how hard we try, we can't keep the Ten Commandments. Who kept them perfectly for us? (*Jesus kept them perfectly for us.*)
9. What does it mean to fear and love God? (*To fear and love God means that we should give Him great respect and devotion.*)
10. Should we be afraid of Him? (*We do not have to be afraid of our loving God. We do need to be afraid of God's punishment if we willfully disobey Him.*)
11. Who helps us keep the faith? (*The Holy Spirit*)
