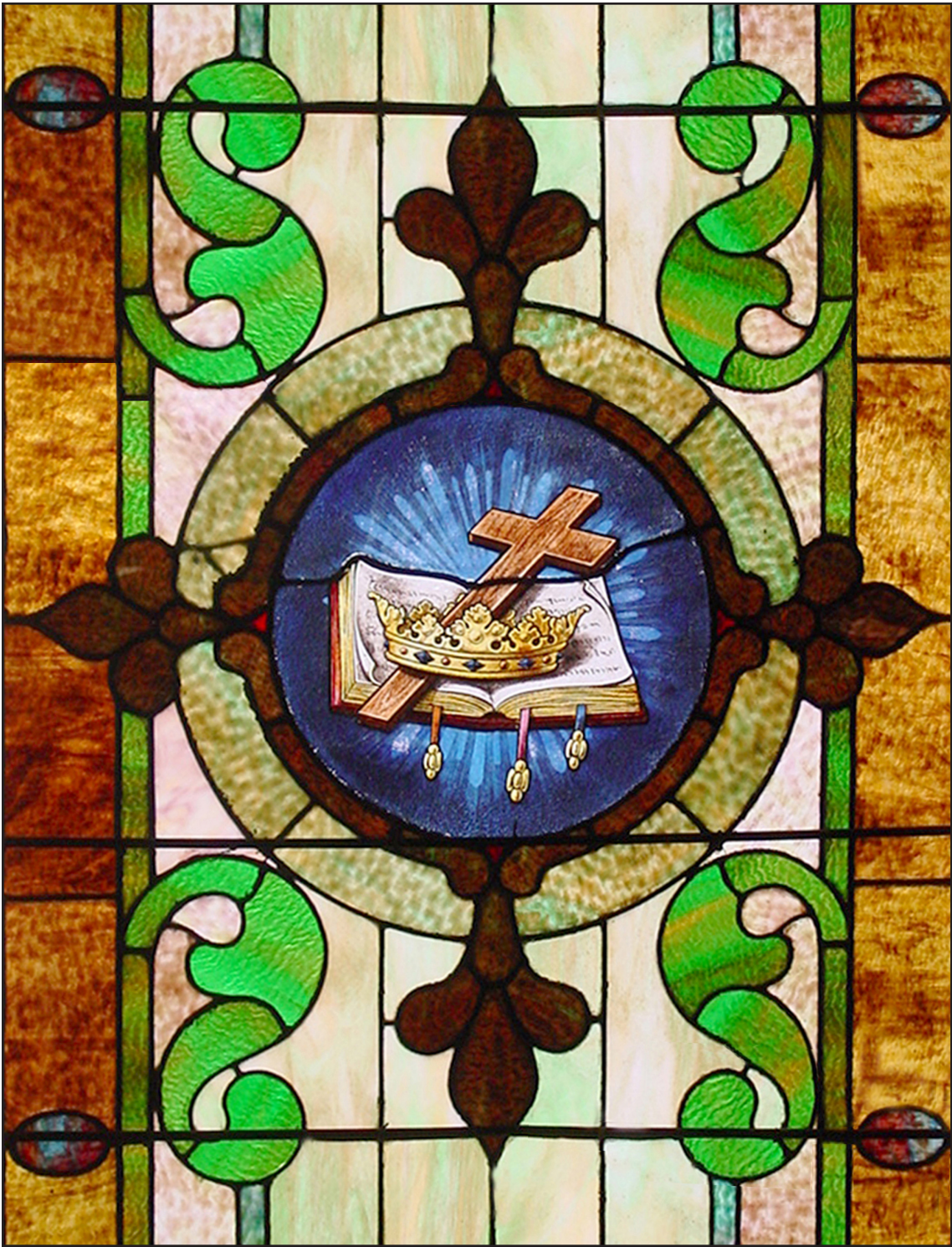


El Reino de los Cielos



Vendré otra vez y os tomaré a mí mismo, para que donde yo esté, vosotros también estéis. Juan 14:3

Juan 14:1-3 - *El Reino de los Cielos*

No se turbe vuestro corazón; creéis en Dios, creed también en mí. 2 En la casa de mi Padre muchas moradas hay; si así no fuera, yo os lo hubiera dicho; voy, pues, a preparar lugar para vosotros. 3 Y si me voy y os preparo lugar, vendré otra vez y os tomaré a mí mismo, para que donde yo esté, vosotros también estéis.

Lucas 15:3-7 - *La Parábola de la Oveja Perdida*

Entonces él les refirió esta parábola, diciendo: --¿Qué hombre de vosotros, si tiene cien ovejas y se le pierde una de ellas, no deja las noventa y nueve en el desierto y va tras la que se perdió, hasta encontrarla? 5 Cuando la encuentra, la pone sobre sus hombros gozoso,

6 y al llegar a casa reúne a sus amigos y vecinos, y les dice: “Gozaos conmigo, porque he encontrado mi oveja que se había perdido”. 7 Os digo que así habrá más gozo en el cielo por un pecador que se arrepiente, que por noventa y nueve justos que no necesitan de arrepentimiento.

John 14:1-3 - *Heaven*

1 “Let not your hearts be troubled. Believe in God; believe also in Me. 2 In my Father’s house are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to Myself, that where I am you may be also.”

Luke 15:3-7 - *The Lost Sheep*

He told them this parable: 4 “What man of you, having a hundred sheep, if he has lost one of them, does not leave the ninety-nine in the open country, and go after the one that is lost, until he finds it? 5 And when he has found it, he lays it on his shoulders, rejoicing.

6 And when he comes home, he calls together his friends and his neighbors, saying to them, ‘Rejoice with me, for I have found my sheep that was lost.’ 7 Just so, I tell you, there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who need no repentance.”

A Closer Look: *The Lost Sheep*

Luke 15:3-7

1. **What is a parable** (*an earthly story with a heavenly meaning*)
2. **Who are the sheep in this story?** (*We are*)
3. **Who is the Shepherd?** (*Jesus*)
4. **How can we get “lost”?** (*Unbelief, sinning, forgetting about Jesus*)
5. **Where does Jesus leave the 99 sheep while He looks for the lost?** (*In a safe place*) **Name some safe places where Jesus would leave His sheep.** (*With other Christians, in a Christian family, in the Word*)
6. **How are we “found”?** (*Hearing the Word, talking to God in prayer, confessing our sins*)
7. **Where will we be with Jesus forever?** (*Heaven*)
8. **When the lost is found, all of heaven rejoices. Why do you think this is true?** (*All in heaven know the lost will spend eternity with God.*)
9. **Have you ever lost something very special? What did you do when you found it?** (*You wanted to tell others.*)
10. **Have you known someone who was “lost” to God? What did you do to help them find their way back?**
11. **How can you help someone who is “lost” find Jesus?** (*Tell them what God has done for you and for them. Read the Bible with them. Talk to God with them.*)
