## La Venida del Espíritu Santo



Y al decir esto, sopló y les dijo: --Recibid el Espíritu Santo. Juan 20:22 Hechos 2:1-8, 41- La Venida del Espíritu Santo

Cuando llegó el día de Pentecostés estaban todos unánimes juntos.

2 De repente vino del cielo un estruendo como de un viento recio que soplaba, el cual llenó toda la casa donde estaban; 3 y se les aparecieron lenguas repartidas, como de fuego, asentándose sobre cada uno de ellos. 4 Todos fueron llenos del Espíritu Santo y comenzaron a hablar en otras lenguas, según el Espíritu les daba que hablaran.

5 Vivían entonces en Jerusalén judíos piadosos, de todas las naciones bajo el cielo. 6 Al oir este estruendo, se juntó la multitud; y estaban confusos, porque cada uno los oía hablar en su propia lengua.

7 Estaban atónitos y admirados, diciendo:--Mirad, ¿no son galileos todos estos que hablan? 8 ¿Cómo, pues, los oímos nosotros hablar cada uno en nuestra lengua en la que hemos nacido?

41 Así que, los que recibieron su palabra fueron bautizados, y se añadieron aquel día como tres mil personas.

## Acts 2:1-8, 41 - The Holy Spirit Comes at Pentecost

- 1 When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place.
- 2 Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting.
- 3 They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. 4 All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.
- 5 Now there were staying in Jerusalem God-fearing Jews from every nation under heaven. 6 When they heard this sound, a crowd came together in bewilderment, because each one heard them speaking in his own language.
- 7 Utterly amazed, they asked: "Are not all these men who are speaking Galileans? 8 Then how is it that each of us hears them in his own native language?"
- 41 So those who received his word were baptized, and there were added that day about three thousand souls.

## A Closer Look - Pentecost

## Acts 2:1-8, 41

- 1. Why were so many visitors in Jerusalem? (It was the Feast of Pentecost, a time to celebrate God's blessings.)
- 2. Why were the disciples and others together in one room? (The Feast of Pentecost was a time of fellowship with other Jews.)
- 3. What sound was heard? (a sound like a violent wind)
- 4. Were the disciples the only ones that heard the wind? (No, the God fearing Jews also heard the sound.)
- 5. How did the Holy Spirit appear? (as tongues of fire)
- 6. What could the believers do after the Holy Spirit came? (They could speak in the languages of all present)
- 7. How many were baptized that day? (3000)
- 8. What does the Holy Spirit do in your life? (He keeps you in the faith. He gives you the power to forgive the sins of others.)
