## Love's Long Journey - #3 of the Love Comes Softly Series

Do you think that people see kindness and goodness in you?

When one of the ranch hands had too much to drink in town, he revealed information about Willie and Missie's finances to outlaws that put the family and their workers in jeopardy.

Why do you think that people drink too much? Could it be an escape from real life? Does it really solve problems or create bigger ones?

When the outlaws came to rob them, it was Missie who rescued their savings and their lives. God can use each of us for good in the lives of others if we let Him.
