**Back to the Drawing Board** - When Nick and Todd had the opportunity to compete in the winter carnival poster contest neither one of them won. The winning poster was Derek's. There is more to life than beating someone else. No matter what we do and how good we are, there will always be someone who will be better yet. Our goals should be much higher than competing against other people.
