Brighten the corner where you are!

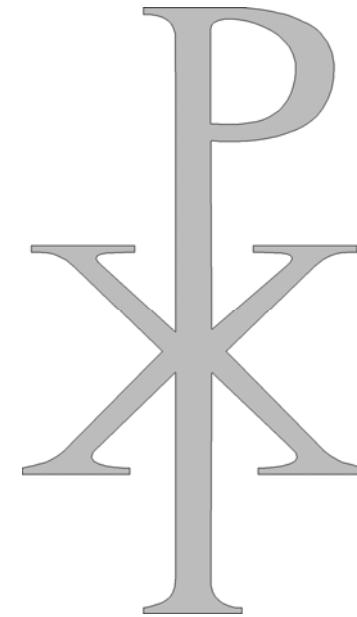
Just above are clouded skies that you may help to clear,
