In the night season and all the day long.

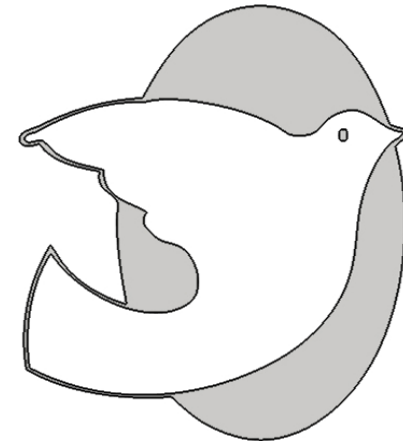
Sometimes on the mount where the sun shines so bright,
