That we fail not man nor You!

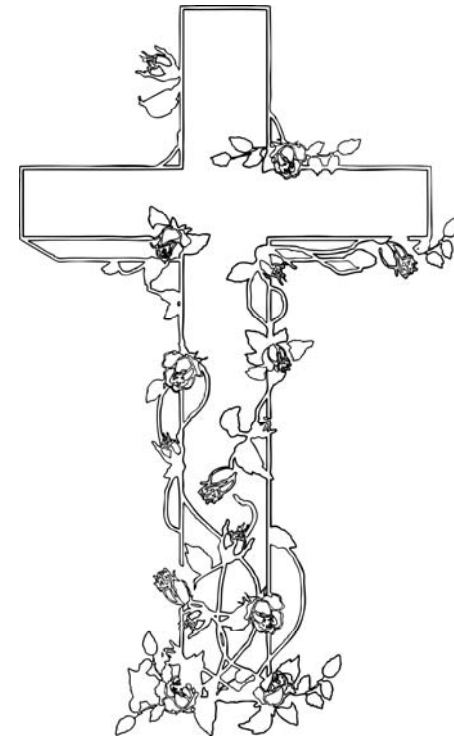
