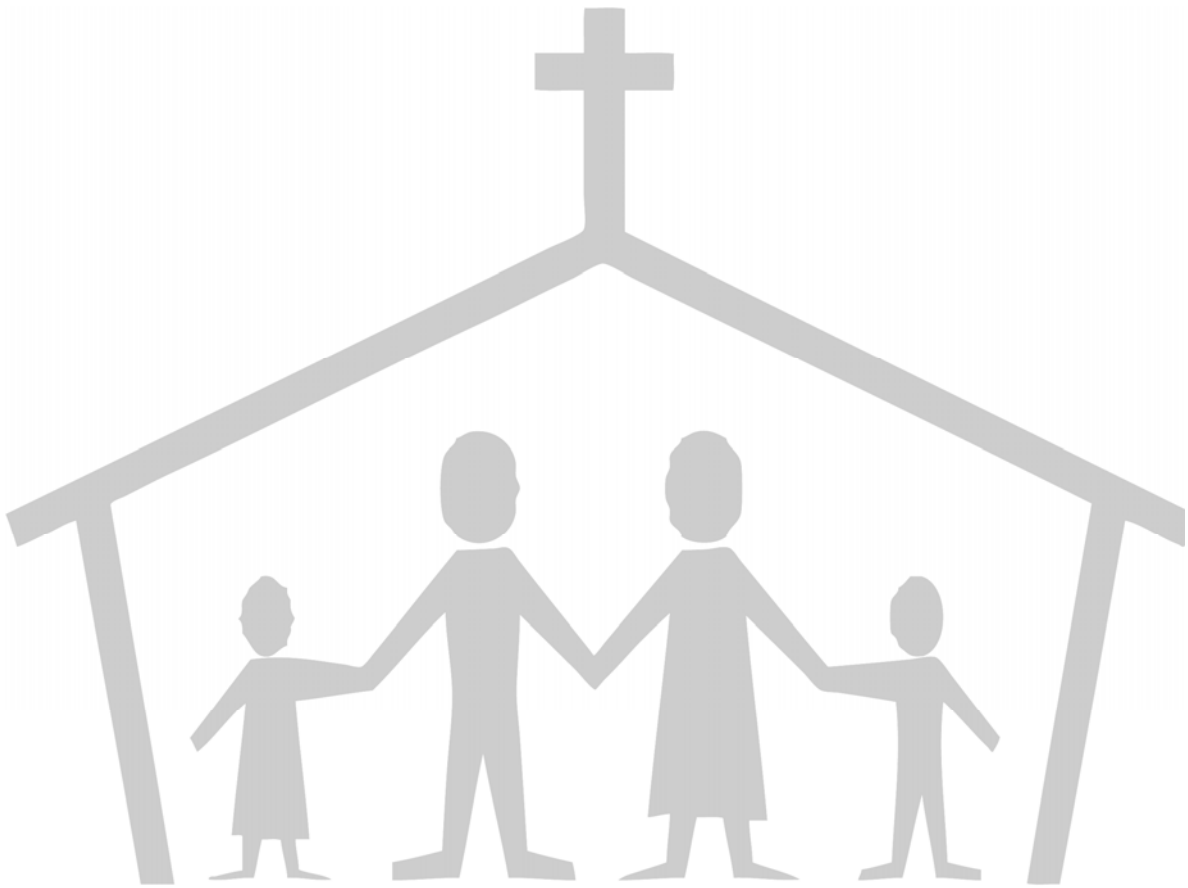


# LOOK CAREFULLY HOW YOU WALK
