This our hymn of grateful praise.

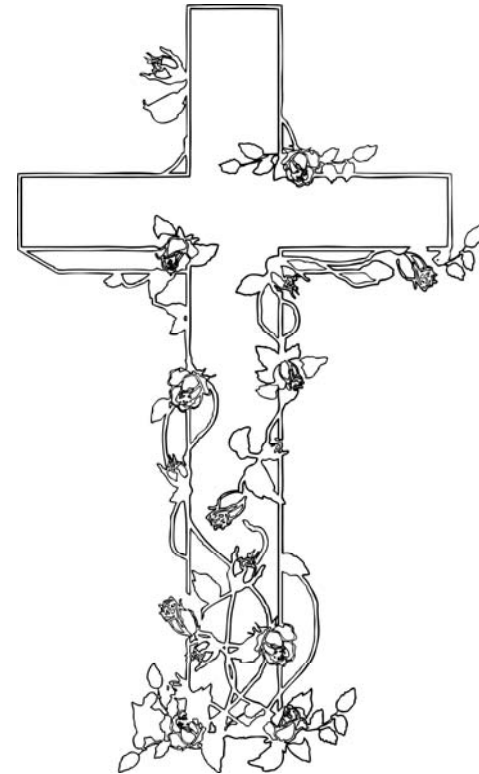
Blessing
